Meaning of cadence

A cadence can be defined as a resting point in a musical composition. In Music, there are such punctuation marks, as full stop, commas and so on.

Types of cadence

1 Perfect or full close cadence: This serves as a full sentence which usually end with a full stop.

The chords are V - I

- 2 Imperfect or half close cadence :It is half close because, it does not give a sense of conclusion. The tonic chord is I - V
- 3 Plagal or Amen cadence: It has a sense of conclusion like the perfect cadence, but it is often used for Amen. The tonic chord is IV I
- 4 Interrupted or deceptive cadence : It creates an impression of surprise or deceit. The chord is V VI
