THIRD REPUBLIC POLITICAL PARTIES

The Armed Forces Ruling Council under General Ibrahim Babangida ushered the third republic political parties. There were only two registered political parties in the ill-fated third republic, namely:

1. NATIONAL REPUBLICAN CONVENTION (NRC)

The party was registered through the approval of the Armed Forces Ruling Council (AFRC) with Chief Tom Ikimi as national chairman. It had its registered office at Abuja, states, Local Government Headquarters and Wards in the country.

- b. To attain political power through democratic and constitutional means.
- c. To promote participatory democracy at all levels of Government

Also, the registration of the SDP was approved by AFRC with Chief Tony Anenih as its national Chairman. It had its registered offices in FCT, Abuja, all the states of the federation, local government Headquarters, the Abuja Area Councils and in all the Wards in the Federation.
