The Message of God:

A message is a means by which we communicate with each other.

God communicates with us through His Prophet, which serve as His messenger or spokes man

Jonah as a Messenger (Jonah 1: 1-17 & 2: 1-10)

- 1. Jonah, the son of Amittai, received a call from God to preach against the wickedness of the people of Nineveh, that all their evil had come up before Him.
- 2. Jonah refused to go as God instructed and wanted to escape from the presence of God.
- 3. God caused a great wind upon the sea which threatened to wreck the sheep.
- 4. In fear, passengers threw their luggage into the sea and prayed to their god.
- 5. When the storm was on, Jonah was at the inner part of the ship sleeping.
- 6. The Mariner found him sleeping and asked him to join others in prayer.
- 7. They cast lot to know the offender and Jonah was found guilty of the calamity.
- 8. Jonah confessed that he was running away from God's message TO Nineveh.
- 9. He advised them to throw him into the sea for the storm to cease.
- 10. Jonah was thrown into the sea and the storm ceased.
- 11. The sailor offered sacrifice to God.

- 12. God had prepared a whale fish to swallow Jonah for three days and he prayed for repentance on the third day.
- **13.** God instructed the fish to vomit him at the sea shore of Nineveh which he was running away from.

Significance:

- 1. God created us to worship Him and do His will.
- 2. It is difficult to run away from God's #giving task
- 3. God is everywhere and it is useless to run away from His presence.

The Message (Jonah 3 & 4: 1-11)

- 1. Jonah was in the belly of the fish for three days and nights
- 2. When Jonah was inside the fish, he prayed to God for deliverance.
- 3. God cause the fish to vomit him at the sea shore of Nineveh.
- 4. God ordered Him to go to Nineveh and proclaim His message and he went as instructed.
- 5. When Jonah got to Nineveh, he said: "Yet forty days and the Ninevites shall be destroyed.
- 6. The people of Nineveh heard and they repented by fasting and praying, and God forgave them.
- 7. Jonah was unhappy that God had forgiven the people of Nineveh.
- 8. Jonah went outside the city and sat in a booth, awaiting his death.
- 9. God raised a plant to shade him from the heat and he was happy.
- 10. Jonah was annoyed when God caused the plant to die the next day and he was exposed to the sun.
- 11. Jonah requested God to take his life because of the death of the plant.
- 12. God told him that he was annoyed because of an ordinary plant he did not grow but wanted Him to destroy the great city with more than 120,000 inhabitants.

Lessons:

- 1. We should be ready to answer God's call and deliver His message.
- 2. God is everywhere and it is impossible for us to run away from his presence.
