ADJUNCTS

Adjuncts are adverbial words used to:

- 1. Tell time of action(s);
- 2. Describe manner of action;
- 3. Tell place of action;
- 4. Extent of an action;
- 5. Explain condition that must be met before another action takes place;
- 6. Explain reason for an action, etc.

TYPE OF ADJUNCTS

The following are types of adjuncts:

- 1. Place adjuncts
- 2. Manner adjuncts
- 3. Time adjuncts
- 4. Degree adjuncts
- 5. Reason adjuncts
- 6. Condition adjuncts

Sentences:

Place adjuncts e g.

- 1. The manager travelled to Akure.
- 2. I saw people relocating to remote areas.

Manner adjuncts e.g.

- 1. They behaved foolishly during the meeting.
- 2. She walked in sluggishly.

Time adjuncts e.g.

- 1. The programme starts soon.
- 2. He arrived yesterday.

Reason adjuncts e.g.

- 1. She came home because of the programme.
- 2. He left early in order to beat the gridlock.

Degree adjuncts e.g.

- 1. The man is so poor that he can afford the price of the item.
- 2. That is too bad of your behaviour.

Note: adjuncts can be a word, a phrase and a clause in a given sentence.
