POLITICAL FREEDOM FOR THE ISRAELITES

Political freedom is the freedom from oppression and the positive exercise of one right and capacities in a society. Political freedom also means living in a society based on individual's rights and freedom from the initiation of force by other men.

THE CALL OF MOSES

(Exodus 2:1 - 25; Exodus 3:1 - 15)

The Israelites were oppressed in Egypt after Joseph's death. God made them prosper in spite of their suffering. Pharaoh ordered the killing of male children of the Israelites at birth, but the Hebrew midwives did not do it.

God caused Moses to be born at this time. After three months of hiding Moses, his mother managed to get him adopted by the daughter of Pharaoh. When Moses grew up, he identified with his people and defended their rights.

Moses escaped to Midian, after killing an Egyptian in defense of the Israelites. God appeared to him and appointed him as liberator of His people. The call of Moses was to seek political freedom for his people.

DEBORAH AND BARAK LEAD THEIR PEOPLE TO FREEDOM

(Judges 4)

Deborah was the wife of Lapidoth, she was a judge, a prophetess and a military leader or heroine. Barak was the army commander of the Israelites. Sisera was the Canaanites' army commander in Syria. Deborah and Barak helped to achieve freedom for the Israelites after 20 years of suffering under Jabin, King of Canaan due to their sin.

God instructed Barak through Deborah to go to war with Sisera,the commander of the Canaanites' army in Syria. Barak insisted that Deborah must go with him to the war. For this reason, Deborah declared that the glory of the war will be given to a woman.

Sisera ran away from the war front because the Hand of the Lord was against him. He fled to the tent of Jael (a woman) and asked for water but Jael gave him milk in return. While Sisera was fast asleep, Jael took a peg and hammer, and she drove the peg into his temple and he died.

Jael went out of the tent to meet Barak who was still pursuing Sisera. She said "come and I will show you the man whom you are seeking". As Barak stepped into the tent, he saw Sisera laying dead.
