**Period 1: Speech work**

**THE CONSONANTS /k/ AND /g/**

Production steps:

- 1.Raise the back of the tongue towards the soft palate to block air from escaping from the lung.
- 2.Release the air suddenly to produce /k/.
- 3.Repeat the process but allow the vocal cords to vibrate to produce /g/

The /k/ sound occurs in words as:

K:key,sky,clerk

C:cat,actor,clean

CK:bucket,clock,quick

QU:queen,square,unique

CH:chemist,school,stomach

X/ks/ : six,next,taxi

The /g/ sound is represented by letter 'g' in words, eg gift,gum,angle,egg etc.

## **Period2: Grammar**

### **THE PASSIVE VOICE**

Study these structures:

Active Voice= **S+V+O**

Passive voice=**O+be+past participle+by subject.**

To change an active sentence to a passive sentence, the tense of the transitive verb in the active sentence determines the tense of 'be' in the Passive sentence and the verb takes the past participle form,eg

1. He does the job.

The job is done by him.

2.He did the job.

The job was done by him.

3. He is doing the job.

The job is being done by him.

4. He has done the job.

The job has been done by him.

5. He will do the job.

The job will be done by him.
