NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY (NPA).

Nigeria Ports Authority is a statutory body charged with the management, control and general operations of the seaports in Nigeria. The ports authority provides facilities at the Port to ensure effective and efficient sea transportation.

Functions of Ports Authority

- 1. Provision of facilities like berth, cranes, forklifts and navigational aids.
- 2. Maintenance and improvement of ports including dredging for easy passage of ship.
- 3. Provision of warehouse facilities at the dockyard.
- 4. Supervision of loading and offloading of goods.
- 5. Provision of security to monitor the movement of ships, cargoes and people within and around the ports.
- 6. Provision of accommodation for security personnel.
- 7. Collection of revenue in the form of harbor and dock dues.
