CUSTOMS AUTHORITY

Customs Authority is a department in the Ministry of Internal Affairs charged with the responsibility of assessing and collecting customs duties on import, export and goods produced locally.

Functions of Costoms Authority

- 1. Collection of revenue from tariffs and excise duties.
- 2. Supervision of bonded warehouse.
- 3. Compilation of statistical records on export and import trade.
- 4. Prevention of smuggling and seizing contraband goods.
- 5. Supervision of foreign trade by ensuring that only licensed goods are imported or exported.
- 6. Provision of quarantine facilities for the importation of livestock.
- 7. Ensuring that ban on prohibited goods are enforced.
