Meaning ,uses and dangers of home appliances : An appliance is a piece of equipment designed to perform a specific task.

Home appliances are electrical machines which helps in household functions such as cooking, cleaning or food preservation. It can be divided into three namely; major ,small and consumer appliances.

Causes of breakdown of appliances; a)exposed cables b)overloading plugs c) sub standard wiring d) re purposing appliances.

Correct ways of using electrical appliances;

- a) never put electrical wires directly into a wall socket to avoid shock.
- b) If you need an extension cord, run it over the carpet and not under the carpet.
- c) Use appliances as they are meant to be used and not otherwise.
- d) Always get a qualified electrician to do any electrical repairs.
- e) Educate your children about the dangers as well.
