Key Words and their meanings

- 1) **Population**: The people living within a political or geographical boundary.
- Resource: Something that one uses to achieve an objective, eg. Raw materials or personnel.
- 3) **Overcrowding:** The action or event of a space having more occupants than a space can accommodate.
- 4) **Starvation:** This refers to a condition of severe suffering due to a lack of nutrition.
- 5) **Regulate:** This means to control or direct according to rule, principle, or law. Also, it means to adjust to a particular specification or requirement: regulate temperature.
- 6) **Cater:** It means to provide things to satisfy a person or a need, to serve. Also, it means to provide food professionally for a special occasion.
- **7) Birth control:** This means voluntary control of the number of children conceived, especially by the planned use of contraception.
